Automated Line Operator (m/f)

Your Tasks

Work as a production team member, supporting the success of the team in achieving production targets including safety, environmental and quality as well as throughput targets. This position is responsible for loading raw materials onto production and automated production lines, inspection of raw/finished product, packaging and assembly/machine operations on the line.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Load raw material into production and automated production lines including, but not limited to, aluminium castings, iron castings, and steel forgings
- Unload finished parts from production line, confirm in SAP system and pack parts into production transport pallet according to instructions
- Visually check and measure parts using required gages according to instructions
- Read and understand information from SAP system regarding production job numbers; select proper job number to run in SAP based upon information supplied by logistics and production management
- Enter data for parts tracking in SAP computer system
- Set part status for parts taken out of the line and putting parts back into the line
- Label parts clearly and deposit them appropriately
- Properly label and separate all defects produced during machining of parts
- Pay attention to proper labeling of materials and storing areas
- In a timely manner, provide parts and transport containers to guarantee a smooth flow of material
- Take parts to Quality Lab and return parts from the lab back to the machining line
- Check and adjust all essential measurement equipment
- Power machines up and down and reset as necessary
- Constantly monitor workplace screen to check if problems exist and, if so, inform supervisor
- Document tool wear and machinery downtimes in the machine protocol plan
- Operate forklift truck occasionally to move containers of parts to and from production line
- Maintain a clean and orderly work area. Sweep and mop floors, wipe down equipment, remove empty pallets, etc

- Responsible for cleanliness of machines. Pay attention to secure operation and cleanliness of the clamping devices and locators
- Notify supervisor in a timely manner of material requirements (e.g. production and assembly material) to meet production needs
- Responsible for informational flow with required personnel, both written and verbal
- Effective communication with internal (e.g. co-workers, supervisors) and external (e.g. clients, suppliers, certification companies) partners
- Adhere to work regulations, accident prevention regulations, environmental regulations and OSHA/MIOSHA laws
- Continuous improvement of the business environment
- Comply with all Weber Automotive Employee Conduct and Work Rules; Safety rules and Employee Handbook
- Perform other duties as assigned

Required Knowledge and Experience
